Determination of the Belle Valley School Board:

School Policy 7:60-AP1: Within 15 days after the hearing's conclusion, the Board decides whether or not the student is a resident of the District and the amount of any tuition required to be charged as a result of the student's attendance in the District schools; sends a copy of its decision to the person who enrolled the student.

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Should the parent request a review of the Board of Education's Decision, they may make said request to the Regional Office of Education (618-825-3900). The Regional Office of Education will provide the parent with the guidelines associated with said request.

By Law: If a student is determined to be a non-resident, the School District must refuse to permit the student to attend unless the required tuition is paid. Said parent will also be responsible to pay the District \$44.69 per day of previous non-resident attendance.

Board of Education Options:

1. Student is a resident of the district.
2. Student is not a resident of the district. The parent(s) of said student(s) will be required to pay the school district a total of \$44.69 per day/per child, for previous non-resident attendance. Parent(s) will be required to enroll their children in the district that they presently reside.
3. Parent provides Board of Education with a legal Power of Attorney stating: (a) the role and responsibility of the person with whom their child is living, and (b) that the person with whom the child is living has full control over the child(ren) regarding daily educational and medical decisions. BOARD MOTION: No later than March 24, 2017, Ms. A is to provide the Belle Valley Board of Education with:

1. Legal Power of Attorney stating: (a) the role and responsibility of the person with whom their child is living at (//////////), and (b) that the person with whom the child is living has full control over the child(ren) regarding daily educational and medical decisions.
2. If this is not done by March 13, 2017, the Belle Valley Board of Education has determined that Ms. A and her children are not residents of the Belle Valley School District and they will be required to enter the school district where they currently reside; as well as pay the Belle Valley School District a total of \$44.69 per day (2016-2017 school year), per child, which equates to a sum of \$20,199.88. The children's final day at Belle Valley will be March 24, 2017.

If this is not done by March 24, 2017, the Belle Valley Board of Education has determined that Ms. B and her children are not residents of the Belle Valley School District and they will be required to enter the school district where they currently reside; as well as pay the Belle Valley School District a total of \$44.69 per day (2016-2017 school year), per child, which equates to a sum of \$10,099.94. The children's final day at Belle Valley will be March 24, 2017.
